Ceremony to commemorate the completion of the Create Medic Research and Development Center

Announcement

Create Medic Co., Ltd., has completed its research and development center in Kawasaki City, Kanagawa Prefecture, which had been under construction in 2015.

The Create Medic R&D Center is located at Kawasaki INnovation Gateway (KING) SKYFRONT in the Tonomachi district of Kawasaki City. KING SKYFRONT is the flagship science and technology innovation hub of Kawasaki City consisting of a 40 hectare area located in the Tonomachi area of the Keihin Industrial Region that spans Tokyo and Kanagawa Prefecture and Tokyo International Airport (also often referred to as Haneda Airport).

KING SKYFRONT was launched in 2013 as a base for scholars, industrialists and government administrators to work together to devise real life solutions to global issues in the life sciences and environment.

Create Medic has to-date has developed materials and technology for medical equipment focused on catheters with emphasis on developing highly original products that match actual medical needs. Based on this history the new R&D Center was built to accelerate the development of new products with a view to overseas expansion.

Notably, about 50 staff mainly from our development section will work at the new R&D Center concentrating. We expect to strengthen this effort in the future.
